## **IMPORTANT NOTES REGARDING PERSONAL BELONGINGS AND STATIONERY LIST**

**Dear Parents,**

- Kindly make sure to purchase the items exactly as described above.
- Stationery items are not sold at school.
- Students must bring these items to school from the first day of school and throughout the academic year.
- Due to the COVID-19 Health and Safety regulations, sharing of stationery is not allowed under current circumstances.
- Students must take responsibility of their possessions. Deira Private School holds no responsibility for lost/damaged property.
- Students are not allowed to bring in personal effects, e.g. toys, (unless the teacher has requested particular items for educational purposes).
- While DePS understands that students may need to carry small amounts of cash during the school day, we strongly discourage large amounts being carried during the school day. In instances where this is a necessity, DePS will take no responsibility lost cash.

### **Device Policy**

- A 'Bring Your Own Device' (BYOD) policy is in place and developing further. All students are encouraged to bring either a laptop, iPad or tablet to school for the purposes of research. Some classroom activities may also require the use of a device such as quizzes and collaborative work.
- Mobile Phones: For safety reasons, students from Year 3 and upwards are allowed to bring their mobile phone to school, only after Parents sign a disclaimer to allow their child to bring a mobile phone to school and agree to the Terms and Conditions.
- Students who have parent's permission to bring their mobile phones MUST keep them switched off during the school day.
- If students are seen or heard using the mobile phones they will be confiscated. The phone will be returned at the end of the day. If the phone is taken twice, it will be kept overnight. If the phone is taken for a third time it will be returned to parents only following a meeting and agreement on the parameters of future use.
- If students need to contact their parents during the school day, they MUST NOT use their mobile phone, even if they think that it is an emergency. They should inform their teachers who will arrange for the students to contact home should it be appropriate.
- If a student is unwell, they must go and see the school Nurse in the first instance with prior permission from their teacher. If the Nurse feels that it is necessary for the student to go home, they will contact their parents and arrange for the student to be collected.
- The wearing of headphones is not permitted around the school or within lessons, unless they are needed as part of that lesson.
- Deira Private School does not take any responsibility for damage to or loss of such items which should be insured by the home.
